End of waste case information for digestate derived products

1. Is REAL expecting the project methodology to include sampling and laboratory analysis of the digestate derived products, or is this information available from the Digestate Characteristics and Valorisation Options project?

Yes, if it is not covered in the data from the Digestate Characteristics and Valorisation project.

2. Is REAL expecting the project methodology to include sampling and laboratory analysis of the non-waste comparator materials?

Yes, if no recent data is available.

3. The new project will build on the information presented in the Research Hub digestate valorisation report. The report is not publicly available. Could we receive a copy of the Digestate Data Pack and Valorisation Report free of charge to prepare the proposal?

The Digestate Data Pack and Valorisation Report is not available free of charge at the tendering stage.

4. The new ADRF is expected to indicate acceptance of other forms of AD, such as Dark Fermentation. Will digestate arising from DF be within scope here?

All discussions around the ADRF are confidential at the moment. You would need to approach the environment regulators and ask the questions.

5. Can you confirm that the scope below will investigate the use of AD digestate derived biochar as an 'end-product'?

The use of biochar goes beyond the scope of this project, biochar is not a digestate and it's not clear how it could meet the end of waste requirement

6. If we apply as a consortium as the lead, should the subcontractor delivery team and their track record be included in the main body of the tender application?

Yes, please include details of any sub-contractors in the main body of the tender application
